



- 1) USB Hub is a device that plugs in a USB ports in which you plug cables from USB devices.
- 2) USB hubs are often built into equipment, normally keyboards, or monitors or printers.
- 3) A bus-powered hub is a hub that draws all its power from the host computer's USB interface
- 4) In contrast a self-powered hub is one that takes its power from an external power supply unit and can therefore provide full power (up to 500mA) to every port.
